“Mesmerize” by Anna Garrison is on display at Brian Scott Gallery

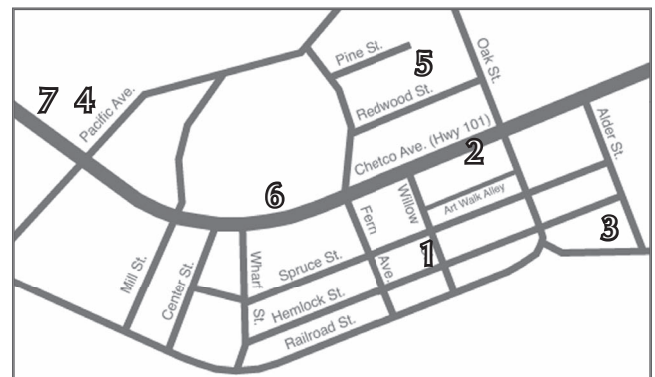
## 3-6 p.m. June 9

### Venues

- 1** **Ambiance by the Sea, 530 Hemlock St., 541-254-4097:** Ambiance offers an eclectic mix of original art and collectibles, including birdhouses, pottery, art glass, driftwood art, and more. **Music by Patty Anne D’Cunha.**
- 2** **Brian Scott and Signatures galleries, 515 Chetco Ave., 541-412-8687:** The featured artist is Anna Garrison. The gallery’s multi-level format shows art in many styles, including art from Signatures, gallery within the gallery. And there’s a fine restaurant downstairs. **Music by Lon Goddard.**
- 3** **Chetco Community Public Library, 405 Alder St., 541-469-7738:** In the meeting room/gallery, “Brookings” is the theme of art by Jay Mosby, Audi Stanton, Les Cornish, and John Gehl. Lobby showcase is “Our Library World” by Kids Librarian Linda Young.
- 4** **Feather Your Nest, 800 Chetco Ave., 541-469-4300:** The featured artist is Lisa Reinshagen, who makes repurposed garden art. And there are works by several other artists, including photo cards, jewelry, driftwood mobiles, and various other craft items and collectibles. **Music by Rapp Brush.**
- 5** **PBAA/Manley Art Center, 433 Oak St., 541-469-1807:** The gallery display Azalea Festival art. The classroom hosts Chetco Photographers, Tuesday Painters, Life Drawing, Mudslingers, Fiber Arts, and more. **Music by Robert Kosslyn.**
- 6** **Semi Aquatic Gallery, 654 Chetco Ave., 503-451-3775:** The gallery features art by owner Spencer Reynolds, who creates beach-themed art and offers art classes from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Saturday or by appointment. **Music by Matt Stump followed by Steve and Laura Nelson.**
- 7** **Wright’s Fog and Fine Arts Gallery, 810 Chetco Ave., 541 469-7900:** Featured is community college art from students of Gary Christianson. This gallery/art store/classroom has art from 37 artists — jewelry to oil and watercolor paintings. Also, art supplies, framing services, and art classes Wednesdays and Fridays. **Music by Billie Ruth Furuichi followed by Ken Dobberpuhl.**
