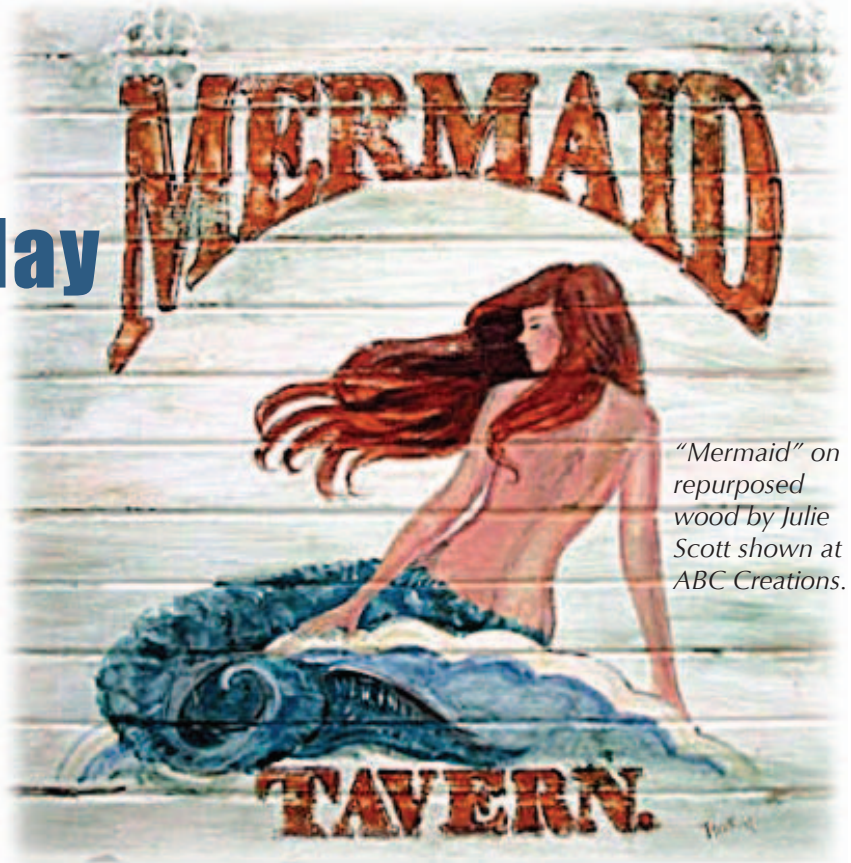


Downtown Brookings Second Saturday

- 1** Times 7D Gallery, 519 Chetco Ave., 530-737-8076: Features the large-format color photography of Tom Krenecki, as well as art created by others.
- 2** ABC Creations, Lower Level, Art Walk Alley and Willow Street, 541 661-7930: The featured artist is Julie Scott who paints on repurposed wood. ABC also has paintings, fabric art, sculpture, barn wood art, pottery, jewelry, fabric and other supplies. Music by Billie Ruth Furuichi and Taste o' Honey.
- 3** Ambiance by the Sea, 530 Hemlock St., 541-254-4097: The featured artist is Tom Moody. There is also an interesting, eclectic selection of original art and collectibles, including birdhouses, pottery, art glass, driftwood art and more. Music by Toni Land.
- 4** Brian Scott and Signatures galleries, 515 Chetco Ave., 541-412-8687: Special event at 4:30 p.m. — meet featured artist Angela Ewing. And this large, multi-level gallery offers art from more than a dozen other artists, as well as the artists of Signatures, a gallery within the gallery. There's also a fine restaurant downstairs. Music by Lon Goddard.
- 5** Feather Your Nest, (new location) 800 Chetco Ave., 541 469-4300: Features the works of several artists, including photo cards, jewelry, driftwood mobiles, and various other craft items and collectibles. Music by Patty Ann Da'Cunha.
- 6** PBAA/Manley Art Center, 433 Oak St., 541-469-1807: Home of Pelican Bay Arts Association. Special event, 4 p.m. — interview with featured artist Karen Vogl. Gallery theme is "Edibles." Classroom has art, too, and hosts Tuesday Painters, Life Drawing, Mudslingers, Chetco Photographers, Fiber Arts, and more.
- 7** Wright's Fog and Fine Arts Gallery, 810 Chetco Ave., 541 469-7900: Special event at 3 p.m. and 5 p.m. — A mask-making demonstration by Aiden Lile. The featured artist is Jaymie Allen (melted crayons). The gallery displays works by 37 artists — jewelry to oil and watercolor paintings. Also, art supplies, framing services, and art classes Wednesdays and Fridays. Music by Shirley Hyatt.
