CLASS - ADULT CLASSIFICATION DEFINITIONS

PLEASE NOTE: There are four classifications for adult artists - you are either a novice, intermediate, advanced, or professional artist.

NOVICE: Artist creating work less than two years and has not won any award.

INTERMEDIATE: Artist creating work more than two years or who has received a first, second, or third place as a novice.

ADVANCED: Artist who has received a first, second, or third place as an Intermediate and/or been accepted in a juried show.

PROFESSIONAL: Artist who offers instruction, hangs in private galleries, or whose reputation is as a professional.

DEFINITION OF STUDENT CLASSIFICATIONS

ELEMENTARY: Students in grade 1-5 **MIDDLE SCHOOL:** Students in grade 6-8 **HIGH SCHOOL:** Students in grade 9-12

CATEGORIES OF ART:

* (1) 2-D ART; (A) Acrylic, (O) Oil, (W) Watercolor, (D) Drawing, (P) Pastel, (M) Mixed Media,

*Indicate medium - Example: 1 A = Acrylic, 1 P = Pastel, 1 W = Watercolor

(2) Digital Art, Photography, Computer-Generated Art (non-photography)

(3) Three- Dimensional: Fiber and Textile, Jewelry, Pottery (no commercially molded), Sculpture

ARTIST'S AGREEMENT: *Please initial that you have read and agreed to #1*

1. _____ My submitted works are 100% original in concept, design and execution. No work is copied from copyrighted or published material including social media websites, is not class or workshop art and is in its first printing for derivative works example - digital photography or fabric design.
2. ALL art must be framed with a secure frame or gallery wrap and works must be ready for hanging with a secure wire system. (NO sawtooth hangers) If the art is not ready for hanging it will be rejected.
3. ALL art must have been created within the past two years.
4. NO Giclées or prints of original art will be accepted.
5. NO duplicate pieces of art will be accepted.
6. NO entries from past Azalea Festival Art Shows will be accepted.

Artists will not hang or remove their own work; the exception will be 3-D art that the artist must handle while accompanied by Festival personnel.

A 25% commission will be paid to Pelican Bay Arts Association on all sales by adult artists, 15% on student art.

I understand that the Pelican Bay Arts Association, its organizations and all persons assisting with the project shall not be held liable for loss or damage of my art work.

Pelican Bay Arts Association will not be responsible for art work not claimed by 6PM Sunday, May 24. Your claim check will be needed to pick up your art. If you are unable to pick up your own art, please make arrangements to have someone pick up your art at the appropriate time.

THE RECEIVING/REGISTERING SHOW PERSONNEL MAY AT THEIR DISCRETION CHANGE CLASSIFICATION /CATEGORY AND MAKE FINAL DECISIONS AS TO ACCEPTIBILITY OF ART WORK. Particular attention will be paid to originality. We expect that all submitted art will be original in concept, design and execution.
