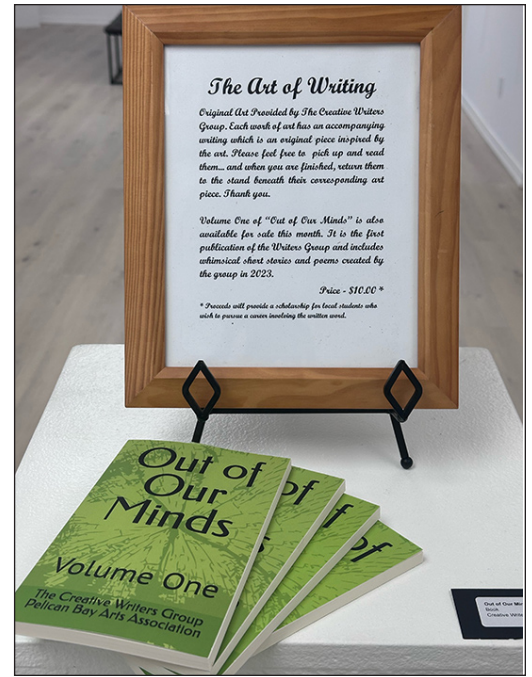




Theresa Herninko displays her paintings at Semi Aquatic Gallery.
