Curry County Master Gardener's (CCMG) Plant Sale is growing! This year we are expanding our annual plant sale into a selective craft and horticultural fair. We cordially invite you to be a part of our new venue. This year, the Wine Festival will take place in the Event Center, next door to our Plant Sale. Before you apply, please make sure your work meets the following criteria. You may not apply in more than one category with the same body of work. CCMG reserves the right and responsibility to ensure compliance with the rules.

Rules for Participation

1. All work must be designed and executed by the accepted artist. No reproductions other than the accepted artist's are permissible. No more than two artists may collaborate on work, both must be included on and sign the application.
2. Artists must be present with their work for the entire fair. Individual artists are required to check in at the Information Booth upon arrival. Photo ID is required.
3. Artists may only show work in the categories submitted on their entry form. All work exhibited must be of the quality and type of work as described on the entry form. Only artists accepted in the jewelry category may display and sell jewelry.
4. All work shown must be for sale.

Acceptance Process

Review of the Applicants is done anonymously by a qualified panel. Each of the following criteria is looked at: quality of work; innovative expression; and technical expertise. Artists will be notified of acceptance in early April. Please email terryyantist@gmail.com with any questions.

Application Procedure

Complete all parts of the Application / Registration Form. Use a separate form for each category (photocopies permitted).

1. Label and enclose 5 digital photos - 4 of your work and 1 of your booth set-up, per category, in a clear protective cover, or email photos as an attachment with your application to terryyantist@gmail.com
2. Label photos with applicant's NAME and NUMBER to correspond with the photo description.
3. Complete the Photo Description section of the Application.
4. Complete the Artist Statement.
5. Enclose check or money order, (\$25 Postmarked by March 1, 2014, or \$35 for late application postmarked by March 26, 2014) in US currency only, payable to CCMG. Applications received after March 26, 2014 will be returned unopened.
6. If you would like your photos returned, please check the box in the "Photo Description" section, and we will return your photos when you check in.
7. Sign and date the Release on the Application / Registration Form.

BOOTH FEES

Single Spaces \$25 – single spaces may have two accepted artists. Tables and chairs are available. If you do not need a table, please let us know.
Double Space \$40
Electricity \$5 additional – Limited availability.

CCMG Plant Sale is exclusively indoors. Please request electricity only if absolutely required. Heavy duty extension cords and power strips must be provided by each booth requesting electrical hook-up. Hoses and / or watering can must be provided by each booth requesting water access.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Target Audience – The population of Curry County Oregon is approximately 22,300 with the median average income of \$30,100 annually. At events similar to the Annual CCMG Plant Sale, successful exhibitors typically had work available for under \$40. remember this is a great opportunity for Mother's Day gifts, and our traffic will double with the attendance of the Gold Beach Wine Festival.

Cancellations and Refunds – We will refund 50% of your booth fee if you cancel out of the Plant Sale on or before April 10, 2014. Cancellations on or after April 11, 2014, are non-refundable.

Liability and Insurance – Each participant exhibits at his or her own risk. CCMG is not responsible for damage, theft, or loss of an individual's work.

BOOTH SET UP

The Plant Sale is located in the Showcase Building at the Curry County Fairground, in downtown Gold Beach, Oregon. You may set up your display / table on May 9, 2014, from 12:00PM to 4:00 PM. Master Gardeners will be opening the door on May 9th, from 4:00 to 7:00PM for a "Pre-Sale" to our plant sale helpers. You may join us in the Pre-Sale Event. On Saturday May 10th, 2014 Exhibitors may set-up starting 8:30 AM Tables and displays may not be dismantled until the end of the sale at 7:00 PM.
