

# DNACA's 33rd Annual Juried Multimedia Exhibition

*Wednesday August 7, 2024 - Wednesday October 2, 2024 ~ Del Norte County Courthouse*

**Eligibility:** All Northern California and Southern Oregon artists.

## **Provisions/Limitations:**

1. Only media that are **easily hung** may be entered; size limit is **30 inches on any side**, including frame.
2. Submitted work(s) must have been completed in the last two (2) years.
3. No more than two (2) works per artist may be submitted.
4. **A label with the artist's name, address, phone number, artwork title, and medium must be placed on the back of each work. Pieces may be signed; however, signature will be covered during judging.**
5. No group work may be submitted.
6. **All fine art pieces must be originals, not reproductions or giclées. Prints are allowed only if original (such as in linocut and other printmaking media).**
7. No work can be accepted that has been previously shown in one of DNACA's Juried Multimedia Exhibitions.
8. Submitted items must be dry, suitably framed (if applicable), and wired ahead of time for hanging. The hanging apparatus needs to be picture wire suitable for the weight of the piece mounted on the back, stretched fairly tightly between two eye screws on either side of the frame or work. No "claw" hangers.
9. No art will be released before the breakdown of the exhibit after the reception (if reception is held), i.e. before 3 p.m. on October 2, 2024.

## **Entry Fees:**

1. A non-refundable fee of \$10 per entry is required at the time of submission (cash or checks only).

## **Delivery/Pick up of the Artwork:**

1. Artwork, along with your entry forms and fees, should be delivered between 4 p.m. and 5 p.m. on **Wednesday August 7, 2024** to the **Del Norte County Courthouse, 450 H St in Crescent City**. Alternative arrangements may be made by calling the DNACA office **in advance**: 707-464-1336. Friends of artist may drop off art, forms, and fees if artist is not able to do so themselves.
2. Submission of artworks to this show constitutes an agreement to all the conditions set forth in this prospectus and the entry form, including permission to reproduce the artworks for publicity purposes.
3. Artists whose pieces have not been selected to be in the show will be notified by telephone or via e-mail the following workday, at which time arrangements should be made to pick up the artwork(s). (Artists may not return on August 7th to pick up artwork not juried into the show.)
4. **All items juried into the show must remain up for the duration of the exhibit and (if held) its reception.**

## **Classifications/Jurors/Awards:**

1. For the purposes of this show, all media shall be judged against each other.
2. The show will be juried and judged by two professional artists of varying media from Curry, Del Norte, and/or Humboldt counties.
3. Modest cash awards (commensurate with the number of entries) will be given for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> places. Up to five (5) honorable mentions may also be given, at the discretion of the judges.

**Commissions:** A 25% commission is required from the artist on any sales during, or resulting from, this show. Checks should be made payable to DNACA. Thank you!

**Reception:** If allowable, there will be a public potluck reception honoring the artists from **3-4 p.m. on Wednesday, October 2, 2024** at the Del Norte County Courthouse, at which time awards will be distributed. Participating artists are asked to **invite your family and friends** to the event. Artists may take their artwork home at that time. DNACA will notify artists if reception is held.
