DESCRIPTION OF WORKSHOP:

Look Like An Artist! No, I don't mean buy a beret and wear a paint-spattered smock. In this workshop (playshop) we will look at color, value, light and shadow, shapes and perspective – the basic elements that allow us to effectively draw and paint objects we want to depict realistically. We will practice drawing what we see so it appears 3-dimensional. We will use still life objects and the human body to practice these skills.
